Marvel at the Pyramid of Cheops, the largest and most awe-inspiring of them all. Continue to the iconic **Sphinx**, standing guard with the body of a lion and the face of King Chephren, a powerful symbol of Egypt's timeless legacy.

Enjoy leisure time for lunch on your own before continuing to the **Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM)**. Explore its key highlights, including Tutankhamun's golden treasures, colossal pharaonic statues, royal mummies, intricate jewelry, ancient relics, and immersive galleries that bring Egypt's 5,000-year-old civilization to life.

Day 4:

Cruise: Visit Kom Ombo Temple

**Walking Level:** Relaxed**Highlights:** Kom Ombo Temple, Crocodile Museum**Transfers:** Cruise sail to Kom Ombo

Today, you will slowly sail towards **Kom Ombo Temple**, located on the east bank of the Nile River. Upon arrival, visit the unique double temple, dedicated to both the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Haroeris. The Greco-Roman temple of Kom Ombo was built between 190 BC and 219 AD. After exploring the temple, visit the nearby Crocodile Museum before returning to your Nile Cruise and continuing your sail to Edfu.

Steps to Walk: Approximately 4,000–5,000 steps # Facilities: Cruise amenities, restrooms at sites, and sightseeing

What to Bring: Walking shoes, hat, water bottle

What to Do: Visit Kom Ombo Temple, Crocodile Museum

What not to Do: Avoid wandering off from the guided tour

Tip for You: Try Egyptian tea on the cruise sundeck

Overnight: Nile Cruise

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Cruise: Visit Edfu Temple

**Walking Level:** Relaxed**Highlights:** Edfu Temple, horse carriage ride**Transfers:** Cruise sail to Edfu

On arrival, enjoy a horse & Carriage return trip to **visit Edfu temple**, which is considered the best preserved of all Egypt's temples. The temple of Horus at Edfu was built in the Ptolemaic Kingdom between 237 and 57 BC.

You will enjoy the temple construction as well as the myths of ancient Egypt. Return to your Nile Cruise, free time on board while sailing to Luxor via Esna, and enjoy your afternoon tea on the Cruise sundeck.

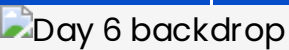

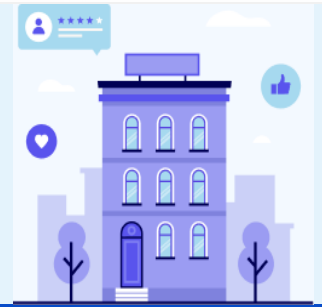
