Amber Fort:

Perched dramatically on a hilltop, the fort offers panoramic views of the surrounding Aravalli hills and landscape. Enjoy a **jeep ride to the fort**, adding a touch of adventure to your royal experience. Explore its magnificent courtyards, ornate gateways, intricate carvings, delicate frescoes, and grand halls, showcasing a fascinating blend of **Rajput and Mughal architecture**.

Jal Mahal:

This five-story pink sandstone structure features more than **900 intricately designed windows**, known as jharokhas, which allowed royal women to observe everyday life while remaining unseen. Its distinctive façade resembles a **royal crown**, making it one of the city’s most photographed monuments.

Enjoy lunch during the tour before continuing your sightseeing.

Jantar Mantar (Observatory):

Explore **Jantar Mantar**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of five astronomical observatories built by **Maharaja Jai Singh II** in the 18th century. Marvel at its enormous astronomical instruments, once used to measure time, track celestial movements, predict eclipses, and study the stars.

After a rewarding day exploring Jaipur’s remarkable heritage, return to the hotel and unwind. Enjoy dinner and an **overnight stay at the hotel**.

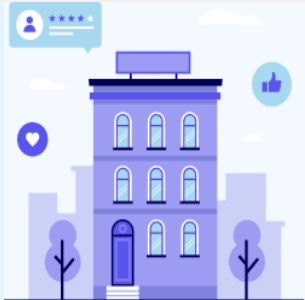

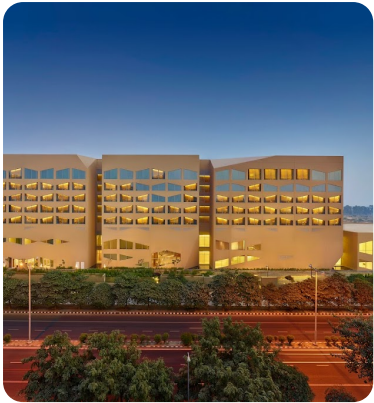
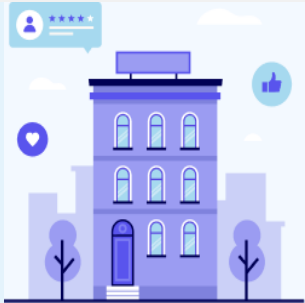
